The preschool years are a time when kids are questioning everything, forming their own opinions, and strengthening their willpower. NLC sees this as a wonderful opportunity in teaching our Discovery Zone kids the TRUE character of God.

SPIRITUAL LIFE:

Be committed to God and to the children here in Discovery Zone Ministries

Regularly attend church services (at least 2x month), participate in worship, and commit to tithing.

Participate wholeheartedly. Worship is not just for the children. Any game can be fun if you want it to be. Be the first to jump up when it is time to get started. Look for people not participating and pull them in. Clap, yell, and jump...when appropriate.

In all relationships and in your home be above reproach in all that you do, being:

sober minded (1 Tim 3:2)

self-controlled (Titus 1:8)

not greedy for gain (Titus 1:7)

not quick tempered (Titus 1:7)

not quarrelsome (1 Tim 3:3)

not a drunkard (1 Tim 3:3) or abusive of substances, including drugs, alcohol (prescription or illegal).

disciplined (Titus 1:8)

Stay sexually pure in all relationships, including personal purity, faithfulness in marriage, and pornography.

Pray regularly for our early childhood ministry, our church and our community.

STUDENT INTERACTION:

Mingle with the children and make newcomers feel welcome. Learn student's names.

Be neat in appearance and dress modestly with the Blue Discovery Zone shirt. Showing the Background Check was completed.

Fragrance free. Please avoid wearing perfumes, aftershaves, smoke products when working in this building as it may cause allergic reactions.

If there's a concern or question about anything involving Discovery Zone Ministries, please contact Pastor Kayla Walker before chatting about the issue or situation with other leaders, parents/guardians, or children.

Rule of 3 – No volunteer is to be alone with a child, another person must be present. In our Crawler and Toddler rooms 2 volunteers must be present to accept children into the room.

If there is a questionable situation in regards to a parent and/or child that may be considered any way abusive, bring it to Pastor Kayla's attention immediately.

Diffuse gossip, rumors and conflict. Stay positive even when things go bad.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

Stand for 1.5 hours.

Bend or twist their body.

Kneel, stoop, crouch, or crawl.

Lift up to 25 lbs.

PRACTICAL FOLLOW THROUGH:

Complete a background check.

Be prepared and ready before your scheduled time.

Follow through on responsibilities (check off lists are located in each classroom).

Be on time for all activities (at least 20 minutes early). If you need to be gone when you are scheduled, it is your job to call a sub from the sub list. Give at least 48 hours' notice if you know you will be absent. Please notify Jenn Pappas of your replacement.

Attend leader trainings and meetings.

No food or beverages allowed in classrooms due to them being a distraction or cause of allergies. (Volunteers 16 or older may have a beverage, as long as it is not a distraction.)

Actively look for ways to make Sundays and Wednesdays run smoother. Our ministry depends on leaders. So be the leader to make it a positive experience for everyone.
